These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the **City of Plum Grove**.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about **March 3, 2021** the **City of Plum Grove**, will submit a request to the General Land Office (GLO) for the release of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds under the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018, and Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2017 (Public Law 115-56) to undertake a project known as **Plum Grove Contract No. 20-065-117-C378-street-EA** for the purpose of **conducting street infrastructure improvements to facilitate proper stormwater conveyance and provide continued ingress/egress to the area.**

Description of Project:

Street Improvements

Subrecipient shall repair and reconstruct the driving surface and road base by applying asphalt, chip-seal over a limestone flex base, and replacing all cross-culverts, driveway culverts and intersection culverts, with incidental repairs to roadside ditches located adjacent to street improvements and complete associated appurtenances.

Location:

All work will occur in the City of Plum Grove, Liberty County, Texas in the following locations:

- FM 1010/Plum Grove Street from Approx. 70 LF north of Road 348 to Approx. 1,830 LF north of Road 351 - (30.202580, -95.095907) 2,040 LF
- FM 1010/Plum Grove Street from Approx. 50 LF north of CR 351 to Approx. 220 LF south of CR 351 - (30.194802, -95.097033) 270 LF
- CR 351 from Plum Grove St. to 50 LF east (30.195016, -95.09694) 50 LF

Project Issues: Floodplains, Wetlands and Historic Preservation: A full, detailed list of mitigation measures can be found in the Environmental Review Record.

Project size: Approximately 1.12 acres.

Total Grant Amount: Project will cost \$405,290 and will be paid for with \$405,290 in HUD CDBG-DR grant funds administered by the General Land Office.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The **City of Plum Grove** has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the **City of Plum Grove, 9485 Plum Grove Rd, Cleveland, TX** and may be examined or copied weekdays 9 A.M to 4 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the **City of Plum Grove, 9485 Plum Grove Rd, Cleveland, TX 77327**. All comments received by **March 2, 2021** or within eighteen (18) days following this posting (whichever is later) will be considered by the **City of Plum Grove** prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The **City of Plum Grove** certifies to GLO that **Mary Arrendell**, in their capacity as **Mayor** consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. GLO's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the **City of Plum Grove** to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

GLO will accept objections to its release of funds and the **City of Plum Grove's** certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the **City of Plum Grove**; (b) the **City of Plum Grove** has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by GLO; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Community Development and Revitalization Program, General Land Office at Texas Disaster Recovery Program 1700 N. Congress, Austin, TX 78701. Potential objectors should contact GLO to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
