3. Pledge of Allegiance led by Barbara Norris.
4. Invocation by Jacob Clay
5. Public Comments
6. Motion to approve minutes for May 10, 2021 made by CM Sager, 2nd by CM Chunn, passed unopposed.
7. Motion to add Mayor Barbara Norris to all banking documents made by CM Chunn, 2nd by CM Sager, passed unopposed.
8. Discussion about the City budget- Budget has to be amended due to the attorney fees going well over the budget due to previous mayor. We will have to move some of the money around to accommodate this issue.
9. Table for time clock options for city employees Diana Chunn will be looking into how the quick books time clock works several council discussed quick books was what their companies used for employees. 16. Discussion on lawsuit against council members discussed that lawsuit was dropped and attorney is seeking refund for all fees the city paid.
