

ORDINANCE NO. 1003

PLUM GROVE DOG CONTROL ORDINANCE

An ordinance to protect the citizens of the city of Plum Grove, Tx from bodily injury or damage to property from dangerous and vicious dogs.

- 1) No dog of a dangerous or vicious nature may be at large at any time within the city limits, and it shall be unlawful for any person having such a dog in the possession or control to cause or permit any such dog to be at large in the city.
- 2) If any such dog bites or attempts to bite any person or animal while at large, then the dog is assumed to be of a dangerous or vicious nature.

Enforcement of this ordinance shall be by the Plum Grove Police Chief and the Liberty County Sherriff's Department. All Liberty County laws will be in effect. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to fines to be levied on a case by case bases by the Plum Grove Municipal Court.
