General Allowance of Outdoor Burning OPEN BURNING OF LEAVES, BRUSH, CLEAN WOOD AND OTHER VEGETATIVE DEBRIS Ordiance No. 1011

Open burning, and outdoor burning are allowed inside the City of Plum Grove, unless burning bans are posted by the County of Liberty. All outdoor burning is specifically permitted by this ordinance.

Open burning of leaves, weeds, brush, stumps, clean wood other vegetative debris is allowed only in accordance with the following provisions

All allowed open burning shall be conducted in a safe nuisance free manner, when wind and weather conditions are such as to minimize adverse effects and not create a health hazard or a visibility hazard on roadways, railroads or airfields. Open burning shall be conducted in conformance with all local and state fire protection regulations.

Materials that may not be burned.

Unless a specific written approval has been obtained from the County of Liberty, the following materials may not be burned in an open fire, incinerator, burn barrel, furnace, stove or any other indoor or outdoor incineration or heating device.

- Asphalt and products containing asphalt.
- Any plastic material including but not limited to nylon, PVC, ABS, polystyrene or urethane
 foam, and synthetic fabrics, plastic films and plastic containers.
- Rubber including tires and synthetic rubber-like products.
