ORDINANCE NO. 0215-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLUM GROVE, TEXAS, DECLINING TO APPROVE THE CHANGE IN RATES REQUESTED BY ENTERGY TEXAS, INC.'S "STATEMENT OF INTENT," FILED WITH THE CITY OF PLUM GROVE, TEXAS, ON JANUARY 31, 2022; FINDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, Entergy Texas, Inc. ("ETI") filed with the City of Plum Grove, Texas (the "City") its "Statement of Intent and Application for Approval of Two Voluntary Renewable Option Tariffs, Rider SVRO and Rider LVRO" (its "Statement of Intent");

WHEREAS, the City has duly noticed its consideration of ETI's Statement of Intent and is acting within its applicable authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLUM GROVE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1 That the findings and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are incorporated herein by reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u> That the City **DECLINES** to approve any and all changes in rates, as requested by ETI and as included in ETI's Statement of Intent, and that ETI's proposed new rates **should not be made effective**.

SECTION 3 Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 4 Severability. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall – for any reason – be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part of provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional. City Council declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same, notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether here be one or more parts.

SECTION 5 Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
