

April 2023 Update

Failure to Appear/Warrants

-Multiple Failure to Appears after two Show-Cause letters were mailed. We have set up the FTA/Warrant procedures with Judge Steely.

Comptroller Update

- -Total amount sent to Comptrollers on 03/17/2023 \$93,348.65.
- -Total amount sent to Comptrollers on 04/2023 \$14,002.51.

Citation Audit

-Thirty citations were missing. Chief Frazier was made aware of the missing citations and was able to get the Court a copy of all missing citations. These citations were then entered into NetData and processed accordingly. Fourteen of the citations were dismissed based on being voided by the officer or processed under a different citation number. Sixteen citations were rescheduled and letters mailed to the address on file.

Deposit Audit

-Deposit audit was complete and it was found \$6,064.97 was to be deposited but cannot be found in the SouthSide Bank deposits. Complete audit findings attached.

NetData.

End of May 2022 All citations since Plum Grove Police Department started issuing

citations entered manually into NetData.

Middle of July 2022 NetData went live pulling citations daily from CopSync.

Beginning of March 2023 Court Administrator completed the Citation Audit.

Beginning of April 2023 Court Administrator completed the Deposit Audit for Plum Grove

Municipal Court, findings listed below.

Plum Grove Municipal Court Deposit Audit Findings:

- NetData was not being utilized by Court Clerk and Deputy Court Clerk even though the system was funded and available. Daily cash logs listing paid citations and deposit slips into the SouthSide Bank Court account, were not being kept for financial tracking.
- Upon City of Plum Grove employees taking over Plum Grove Municipal Court there was no knowledge of NetData, the system was not used at that time. Council Member Diana Chunn implemented daily cash logs listing paid citations and policies to keep deposit slips until bank reconciliation at the end of the month.

- All citations prior to July 2022, when NetData went live and pulled down CopSync citations, were manually entered by Court Administrator, City Secretary, and Mayor.
 - During this time any citations that had any receipts attached to them were listed as PAID in NetData. Any citations that were still "open" in NetData were sent reset letters to the defendants. Some defendants did come in with copies of their receipts showing the citations were actually paid partially or in full. Those receipts were copied, citation cases were listed as PAID in NetData, cases were closed (if applicable), and moved to the closed case file cabinet.
- Court Administrator was able to compare all deposits made into SouthSide Bank Court account to all payments entered into NetData. A reconciliation of the two different systems showed a discrepancy of \$6,064.97 in funds listed as collected in NetData but no matching deposits into SouthSide Bank Court account were found. This discrepancy seems to be prior to when the current Court Administrator was appointed and daily deposits from NetData being completed.
 - ➤ It is to be noted that all SouthSide Bank accounts were reconciled April 2022 and no funds were deposited into incorrect accounts.
 - The reconciliation was completed by working from the most recent deposits of March 2023 and comparing the accounts working in ascending order to December 2021.

What Plum Grove Municipal Court is doing moving forward to prevent any further discrepancies.

- Court Administrator utilizes NetData's daily deposit logs to compare payments made via NetData and actual cash on hand prior to bank deposits being made.
- Monthly reconciliations are done by the City Secretary and verified by the Court Administrator prior to financial reports being submitted to the City of Plum Grove City Council.
- Checks and Balances are in place to prevent any further discrepancies of missing funds.
