INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PLUM GROVE AND LIBERTY COUNTY

THE STATE OF TEXAS §

COUNTY OF LIBERTY §

This Interlocal Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered by and between the City of Plum Grove, Texas (hereinafter, "the City"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, acting by and through its City Council and Liberty County, Texas, (hereinafter, "the County") a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, acting by and through its Commissioners Court and pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. §§ 791.001 - 791.030. The City of Plum Grove and Liberty County are referred to herein collectively as "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

Recitals

The County desires the assistance of the City's Police Department in law enforcement matters of mutual concern to the Parties; and

The City is in need of a vehicle for its law enforcement officers' use in the performance of their duties.

Terms

The County agrees to transfer and hereby does transfer titles to certain vehicles, namely a 2017 Ford Explorer with the last 4 digits of the VIN of 5596 and a 2016 Ford Explorer with the last 4 digits of the VIN of 8660, to the City. The City accepts the condition of the vehicle "as-is" with all faults and acknowledges that the County has made no representations as to its condition or fitness for a particular purpose. The County does not warranty the vehicle in any way.

The City agrees to aid the County in law enforcement activities of mutual concern to the Parties that may be identified in the future.

The County has complied with all procurement federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations, or ordinances in the procurement of the vehicle subject to this Agreement.

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as to render the Parties as agents, employees, or subcontractors of the other. No term of this Agreement should be interpreted to limit the independent discretion every peace officer has to file charges or refrain from filing charges, where appropriate.

Each Party shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations concerning the performance of this Agreement. The laws of the State of Texas govern this Agreement.

The term of this Agreement shall commence upon approval of both Parties and shall run for the next consecutive twelve (12) months.

Each Party to this Agreement shall pay for the performance of the obligations created herein from current revenues available only.
